**SUPPLEMENTAL NOTICE OF CURE AMOUNT WITH RESPECT TO EXECUTORY
CONTRACTS OR UNEXPIRED LEASES TO BE ASSUMED AND ASSIGNED**

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT:

1. Pursuant to the Order pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 105(A), 363, 365, and Bankruptcy Rules 2002, 6004, 6006 (A) Establishing Bidding and Auction Procedures Related to the Sale of All of the Debtors' Assets; (B) Approving Bid Protections for the Sale of the Debtors' Assets; (C) Scheduling an Auction and Sale Hearing for the Sale of the Debtors' Assets; (D) Establishing Certain Notice Procedures for Determining Cure Amounts for Executory Contracts and Leases to be Assigned; and (E) Granting Certain Related Relief (the "**Bidding Procedures Order**") entered by the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Southern District of Ohio (the "**Bankruptcy Court**") on May 27, 2009, the above captioned debtors and debtors-in-possession (collectively, the "**Debtors**") hereby provide notice that they are a party to various executory contracts and unexpired leases (individually, a "**Contract**," collectively, the "**Contracts**") and they intend to seek to assume and assign some or all of the Contracts (individually, an "**Assumed**

Contract,” collectively, the “**Assumed Contracts**”) to the Successful Bidder² set forth on Exhibit 1 attached hereto.

2. You have been identified as a party to a Contract that the Debtors may seek to assume and/or assign. The Contract with respect to which you have been identified as a non-Debtor counterparty, and the corresponding proposed amount the Debtors’ records reflect is owing for prepetition arrearages (the “**Cure Amount**”), has been set forth on Exhibit 1 attached hereto. The Debtors’ records reflect that all postpetition amounts owing under your Assumed Contract have been paid and will continue to be paid until the assumption and assignment of the Assumed Contract, and that other than the Cure Amount, there are no other defaults under the Assumed Contract.

3. Objections, if any, to the proposed Cure Amount must be made in writing, filed with the Bankruptcy Court, 221 East Fourth Street, Atrium Two, Suite 800, Cincinnati, Ohio 45402, and served so as to be received by the Debtors and counsel for the Debtors on or before July 9, 2009 at 4:00 p.m. (the “**Objection** Deadline”). Service should be made by mail to (i) Latham & Watkins LLP, counsel for the Debtors, Sears Tower, Suite 5800, 233 S. Wacker Drive, Chicago, Illinois 60606, (Attn: Stephen R. Service should also be made to the Debtors by mail, c/o Global Fastening Solutions, LLC, 4270 Ivy Pointe Boulevard, Cincinnati, Ohio 45245 (Attn: General Counsel), and by facsimile, (513) 388-3371 (Attn: General Counsel) and on the Committee’s counsel by mail and facsimile, Schottenstein, Zox & Dunn Co., LPA, 250 West Street, Columbus, OH 43215 (Attn: Victoria E. Powers) and by facsimile, (614) 462-5135.

4. If an objection to the Cure Amount is timely filed, a hearing with respect to the objection will be held before the Honorable J. Vincent Aug, Jr., United States Bankruptcy Judge, at the United States Bankruptcy Court, 221 East Fourth Street, Atrium Two, Suite 800, Cincinnati, Ohio 45402, on a date as determined by the Debtors. A hearing regarding the Cure Amount, if any, may be continued at the sole discretion of the Debtors. You will have the opportunity to evaluate and, if necessary, challenge the ability of any Successful Bidder to provide adequate assurance of future performance under the Assumed Contracts.

5. The Debtors will file, but not serve, a notice that identified any Successful Bidder and provide notice of the particular Assumed Contracts that the Debtors will seek to assume and assign at the Sale Hearing (the “**Post Auction Notice**”). The Post Auction Notice will be available on the website maintained by the Debtors’ noticing agent at <http://www.sencorp-reorg.com>.

6. The presence of a contract or agreement listed on Exhibit 1 attached hereto does not constitute an admission that such contract or agreement is an executory contract or unexpired lease. The Debtors reserve all of their rights, claims and causes of action with respect to the contracts and agreements listed on Exhibit 1 attached hereto.
